**A RESOLUTION OF THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL CONFIRMING THE JOINT
POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION (JPACT)
REPRESENTATIVES FOR 2019 AND 2020**

WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Advisory Committee on Transportation (JPACT) makes recommendations to the Metro Council on transportation needs in the region; and

WHEREAS, JPACT is made up of 17 voting members of which one position represents the cities of Multnomah County including Gresham, Troutdale, Fairview, and Wood Village; and

WHEREAS, the member and alternate will be from different jurisdictions, one of which will be from the city of largest population; and

WHEREAS, the Mayors and Councils have agreed to appoint Gresham City Councilor Karylenn Echols as the Member and Troutdale Councilor Jamie Kranz as the Alternate to represent the cities on JPACT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FAIRVIEW CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 The City Council hereby confirms the appointment of Gresham City Councilor Karylenn Echols as the Member and Troutdale Councilor Jamie Kranz as the Alternate as JPACT representatives for the years of 2019 and 2020.

Section 2 This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.
