

I. MOBILE HOME PARK ORDINANCE (CORNELIUS/COOPER/GESSNER)


Community Development Director John Gessner summarized information that the Mobile Home Park Committee has gathered and presented the three options that the Council has. One option is to do a first reading of the Ordinance but not adopt it. Another option is to go ahead and adopt it. The third option is to take no action. Director Gessner outlined the four points that the ordinance includes. The consensus of the Council was to do a first reading of the Ordinance but wait to adopt it.

II. BOEC CAD FINANCING (JOHNSON)

Police Chief Ken Johnson introduced the issue with the question of how the Council would like to proceed on the BOEC (Bureau of Emergency Communications) CAD (Computer Automated Dispatch) replacement. Chief Johnson summarized the findings of the BOEC User Group committee, explaining that the cost will be roughly fourteen million dollars. The Council agreed that the best solution is to go to a county wide levy to pay for the system so as not to impact funds of individual jurisdictions.
