**4. PRESENTATIONS**

a. State of the City Address

Mayor Weatherby delivered the State of the City Address. Theme of the Address was where the city was, its' priorities and commitments, and where the city hopes to be in the future. Highlights included Fairview's leadership role in promoting East County as a region, support of the USS Ranger, efforts to attract and promote existing businesses, the 5 year strategic plan, Police Department accomplishments, and the city's efforts in being fiscally responsible in difficult economic times. ## 5. CITY ADMINISTRATOR/DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR'S REPORTS

Police Chief Johnson reported on the debriefing of the officer involved shooting that included all of the organizations that assisted. Johnson stated that the inter-agency cooperation in East County was exceptional and the Fairview Police Department was fortunate to participate in and depend on such an outstanding law enforcement community.

Police Chief Johnson stated he had attended an event meeting for the July 8, 2012 triathlon that would begin and end at Blue Lake Park. Event planners were requesting significant police assistance for managing traffic safety at intersections. There would be significant traffic impacts. He would keep the Council informed as planning developed.

Police Chief Johnson commented that the success of the Prescription Drug Program had far exceeded expectations and to date over 450 pounds of prescription drugs had been turned in.

## 6. MAYOR/COMMITTEE REPORTS AND COUNCIL COMMENTS

Councilor Kreamier commented on the quick response time of the Police Department to a security company call. Though it was a false alarm, it was assuring to know how quickly and professionally they would respond when needed.

Councilor Quinby stated how impressed he was by the success of the Prescription Drug Program and commended the Police Department on initiating such a program.

Council President Jones reported she had received positive responses to the city's new web site; however, there were requests for more detailed minutes. Staff responded they were aware of the requests and minutes would be more comprehensive. Jones complimented staff on the code compliance report.

Councilor Owen offered to purchase an additional DVD of the meeting for Mayor Weatherby and requested staff to order it.

Council President Jones moved to request staff obtain bids from local east county businesses for basic park maintenance and Councilor Owen seconded. 9. ADJOURNMENT


Councilor Quinby moved to adjourn the meeting and Councilor Barton Mullins seconded. The motion passed, and the meeting adjourned at 7:27pm.


